Guidelines and Conditions of Submission

I. CONDITIONS OF SUBMISSION

Submission of a work for publication constitutes a representation and warranty to **SEXTANT** that the work presents original work and complies with academic integrity including no plagiarism. Upon acceptance by **SEXTANT** for publication, the author agrees to the copyright conditions.

In submitting work to **SEXTANT**, the submitting author represents and warrants to **SEXTANT** that all necessary permissions of all named co-authors have been secured, the order of names for publication has been agreed upon by all co-authors, and that the work for publication is free from defamatory, libelous, or fraudulent content.

Permission to quote from or reproduce copyrighted material contained in any work for publication by **SEXTANT** must be obtained by the author before submission. Where the photographs or figures are reproduced, acknowledgment of source and copyright should be given in the caption.

II. GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL PUBLICATIONS

- 1. Title: Provide a title that captures the content of your project. For instance: "The English Boy Among the Derry Girls: Marginalised Masculinities in *Derry Girls*". (Up to 20 words).
- 2. Abstract (100-150 words).
- 3. Keywords: Up to five keywords.
- 4. Your full name: Last name, first name.
- 5. Your email address: Provide a personal email address. Readers might contact you in the future, so make sure you include an email that has no expiration date.
- 6. We welcome submissions in any language. For English-language submissions, please use Irish/UK English.
- 7. When citing sources, follow Harvard style citation. See guidelines <u>HERE</u>.
- 8. Please try to ensure that your submission adheres to the principles of Universal Design for Learning (UDL). See <u>HERE</u>.

III. SPECIFIC GUIDELINES BY FORMAT

A) GUIDELINES FOR ARTICLES/LITERATURE REVIEW/BOOK REVIEWS

- 1. Send us your written material as a Word document (NOT as a PDF).
- 2. Follow Harvard style citation. See guidelines <u>HERE</u>.
- 3. Average Length: 1,500 words. (5,000 words maximum).

4. Font: Single space, Verdana 12.

B) GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE MATERIALS

- 1. Email us a link to your project at sextant@ucd.ie.
- 2. Include all relevant information (name, email, abstract (100-150 words), five keywords, etc.) in this email.
- 3. For online submissions, there are various platforms that you can use, for instance, Padlet (see <u>HERE</u>), Microsoft Sway (See <u>HERE</u>), or Canva (see <u>HERE</u>). Other formats to present your submission are also welcome.

C) GUIDELINES FOR AUDIOVISUAL MATERIALS

- 1. Upload art pieces, designs, photographs, videos, audio recordings or other multimedia pieces via Google Drive and share with us at sextant@ucd.ie.
- 2. Please include the relevant information (name, email, abstract, keywords, etc.) when sharing.
- 3. If, for some reason, this method of uploading is not accessible, email us with a description of the project and your issues with submission.
